| Minimum <br> Percentage Required | An aggregate of 40\% marks in the qualifying examination |
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| Specific <br> Requirements | The merit shall be determined on the basis of one language and three best <br> elective subjects. (List A) |
| Deduction from <br> "Best of Four" | In case more than one non-listed subject is included for calculation <br> of 'Best of Four', a deduction of $2.5 \%$ each in 'Best of Four' may <br> be levied in addition to deduction due to change of stream, if any |
| Calculation of Best <br> of Four Subjects | 1. One Language (Core/Elective/Functional) (List A) <br> 2. Any three elective subjects can be chosen. (List A) <br> 3. One non-listed (List A of Annexure II $)$ subject can be <br> included in calculation of 'Best Four' without any deduction |
| Advantage | If an applicant opts Punjabi/ Sanskrit for Modern Indian Language <br> (MIL)an advantage of up to 2\% may be given in 'Best Four <br> (as per announce in cut-off by the college) <br> Note: only for General category |
