

The event was enlightened by Mr. Anil Swarup, an author and retired Indian Administrative Service officer of Uttar Pradesh. The esteemed speaker delighted the audience by sharing valuable information on the topic Ethics, considering it to be a most debated concern for today's youth. Mr. Anil Swarup started with giving an brief explanation on a major topic, difference between Morals and Ethics, he explained that Ethics deals with right and wrong conduct. Ethics are consistent to a certain context but might vary between contexts. And told us that, Morals deal with the principles governing the same. Morals are comparatively consistent provided the beliefs of an individual does not undergo any alteration. The speaker explained us that when we talk about ethics we are talking about those values which are accepted by the society. They are totally different from the laws, as when they get codified they become law .He also justified that, There is a framework of ethics underlying our lives on a daily basis, helping us make decisions that create positive impacts and steering us away from unjust outcomes. Ethics guides us to make the world a better place through the choices we make. He later took some daily life examples and examples from the book he wrote ,'Ethical dilemmas of a Civil Servant' which explains ethics are the study of morally appropriate behaviour and decisions, and examining what should be done. Ethics helps to mould and shape human behaviour.


The speaker explained, The main importance of ethics in our lives is, To control that part of administrative power and discretion which cannot be controlled by formal laws methods and procedures. To improve the efficiency and effectiveness of administrative process. The scope of ethics spreads over all human relationships which exist in our society. He told us about the interaction with the chief ministers, How he dealed with the issues of the public being a civil servant, he also discussed about what success really means, and justified the statement "Try not to become a man of success rather a man of values" Sharing with his experiences, Mr. Anil Swarup sir has illuminated the audience with his pearls of wisdom.
