The civil society organized a webinar on the topic" navigating the challenges in public service delivery" on 28th January 2022, at 10:00 a.m. on virtual platforms of Google meet and YouTube live. The civil society had invited, I.A.S. Ira Singhal, a civil servant, air-1, UPSC civil services exam,2014 and since then has been serving in various capacities in government of India. The webinar began with an introduction address by the convenor of civil society, Dr. Gopinath Pillai, who also welcomed the speaker. This webinar had been based mainly role and of government as far as providing services to the Indian citizens at large. The speaker explained the dynamics of the entire process by giving very relatable examples and shared her experiences as a field officer. The primary emphasis was laid on the difficulties which are being faced by the civil servants in dealing with social issues confronting the society and the ways they are dealt with. She also highlighted the problems the challenges faced by the Indian state in terms of public service delivery such as inefficiency in the administration in public level, and the passive attitude of citizens in terms of raising voice against corruption in the Indian administrative bureaucracy along with emphasizing the need to fill the gaps through upgradation of civil services who form the permanent executive of India. This was followed by a detailed and student-friendly question-answer session in which the speaker beautifully answered all the questions that the attendees of the webinar had along with explaining different facets of public services like dealing with corruption on a daily basis, abolishing child labor, child marriages and dowry and how citizens could help bureaucrats in dealing with such issues. 
